In addition to the toolkits, Provincial Committees will be providing a series of professional learning sessions to support curriculum implementation, scheduled strategically throughout the 2023-2024 school year.

ARPDC will be hosting three **Summer Curriculum Institutes** to provide support for teachers looking for professional learning on new curriculum.
